All applications will be reviewed and considered by a committee before final sign off on November 23rd, 2022, by the board so please be patient with the process and AIT in this period or review, you will be notified either way on or around this date.

Over the last couple of years, the project has been extremely well supported with volunteers from the community and the volunteer group has been the life blood of the organization. We have witnessed a dramatic adaption of our requirements on the ground since our very first year in Lesotho and are extremely lucky to have had the support and our skill base needs meet by the community for the projects.

We are excited again by this year's project and look forward to again reaching out potential volunteers and we expect the response rate to be no different this year. We are searching for people who can support the group in any of the following areas of expertise Education, Information Technologies, Music, Medical Areas, Planning, Architecture, Farming, Horticulture, Hospitality, Logistics, Social Care, Sports & and Trades from across the building spectrum.

Once you apply you are committing to the project and all it encompasses, this is a travelling group with a larger percentage of young people to adults, anyone applying its desired you have a full clean driving license, you understand you will be Garda vetted and you will be required to complete the children first e-learning program arranged by the school. You also need to be comfortable driving in a foreign country, both day & nighttime. As an Adult Volunteer or parent, it is expected that you will be with the main student group, support the entertainment program for the students for the 2 weeks and attend daytime & evening events (as required/requested).
